

The Play

Kathy is the new girl at Crono Beach High. Shortly after arriving she finds herself being bullied via text & social networking. She is finding it impossible to protect herself from this techno bullying and doesn't know what to do. When a seeming 'nice guy' in her class befriends her she almost leaps at the chance to share her problems; he seems so sympathetic...so genuine...but... can she trust him?

Kathy's dilemma explores techno bullying. The play exposes the misuse of new technologies and offers strong, positive strategies to deal with this growing problem. Actors, who are up to date on the latest legal ramifications of the misuse of technology, lead a friendly but informative debrief session after the play.
